Dear Mr. Chisholm:


I would like to thank you and your fellow Citizens for Bill 103 for your recent letter expressing serious concerns that I share. Please accept my sincere apologies for the delay in responding to you.

As you probably know, I offered my full support to Gary Guzzo's bill, as did many of my colleagues. I believe it is essential for the Ontario government to establish an independent public inquiry into the allegations of police mismanagement during the sexual abuse investigations. The people of Cornwall deserve closure to this painful situation.

I call Bill 103 the "sunshine bill" since I believe it will burn off the fog of innuendoes and allegations that has been shrouding the Cornwall area and shed light on the truth.
