My involvement is as follows:

On or about the 23 September 1993, I gained knowledge of a sexual assault case. I checked OMPPAC. I saw that no reports had been entered. I asked Cst. H. Sebalj if I could see the victim's statement and obtained a copy of same.

After seeing the gravity of the statement and the allegations I had great concerns about the safety of children in our community including members of my own family.

I spoke to Mr. Richard Abell from CAS about the case.

I then had a conversation with S/Sgt. Luc Brunet. He informed me that the case was over and that I should back off as I had a wife and three kids and that I did not want a repeat of 1985.

My concerns were then in two areas. The first was for the safety of children, and the second was for my job.

I then gave Mr. R. Abell a copy of the statement and also contacted my association representative to inform him of my actions.

I was then advised by S/Sgt. G. Derochie that I was being investigated under the Police Act re: the Fr. Charlie case.

I was subsequently notified by my association representative that I was cleared of any Police Act charges involving this case.
