Received your letter this morning. I was glad to read that integration in the oblate province is going very well.

Received a phone call this morning from the Lundar R.C.M.P. A mandate for your arrest is out for you which means that should you come to Canada you would be apprehended at the entry point.

They asked where you were and I told them Belgium but I did not know where. It would seem that there will be no more done about this, unless you decide to come back here to visit me, your brother or whoever.

All is pretty well the same here. Father Charles Ruest is getting weaker and weaker, Father Lemoine is slowly getting worse although he is still able to come to the dinning room. Brother Deschênes is still in his manic phase so the whirlwind still passes every now in then in our midst.

May be able to see you on the way to, or from the canonization.
