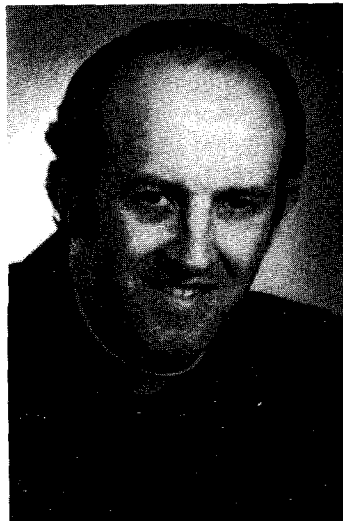
April 25

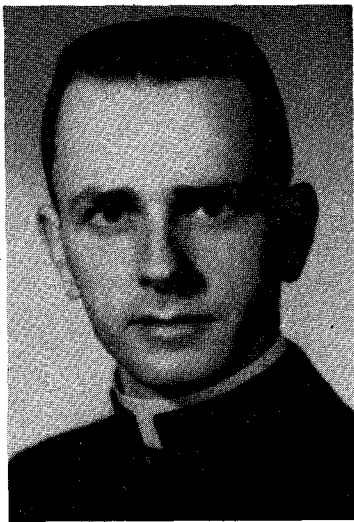
