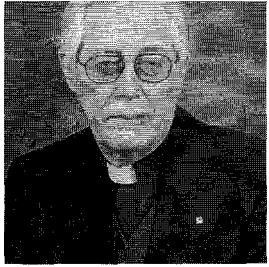
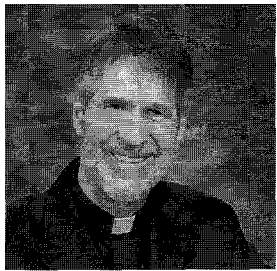


## Msgr. Peter Heinrich Schonenbach, P.H. - 40 years



Msgr. Peter Heinrich Schonenbach was born in Ottawa and is the founding pastor of Holy Redeemer. He exercised parish ministry in several parishes in our archdiocese. He was the diocesan director of the vocations service, diocesan pastoral coordinator, spiritual director of the Central Council of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, regional vicar for Region III (English sector), episcopal vicar for pastoral Region I, a member of the council of priests and Vicar General. In 1998, he was appointed General Secretary of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. He also served as chaplain to the Filles d'Isabelle du cercle Notre-Dame-du-Sacre-Coeur, no 1296, as spiritual director with the Ottawa Cursillo movement and was appointed to several committees and boards: les Scouts du Canada, the Christian Council of the Capital area, the Ottawa Christian-Jewish Dialogue, the Ontario Catholic Conference for Ecumenism, the United Way and the Ottawa-Carleton Social Planning Council.

## Reverend Dennis Hayes, C.C. - 25 years



Born in Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, Quebec, on February 8, 1955, Fr. Dennis Hayes studied at Etienne Brule high school, at Guelph University and at St. Augustine's seminary in Scarborough. He served in a number of parishes in the Ottawa area. He also served as pastor at St. Timothy's Catholic Church in North York, Toronto. He currently serves as Director of Admissions for the Companions of the Cross.

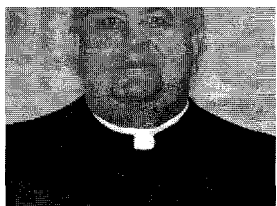
## Reverend Joseph Le Clair - 25 years



Fr. Joseph Le Clair was born on December 8, 1957 in Alberton, P.E.I. He studied at the University of PEI and the Holy Apostles Seminary College. He served in the following parishes: St. Maurice, Holy Cross, St. Leonard, and Blessed Sacrament - where he ministered as pastor for 14 years and just recently finished his term. He served as diocesan chaplain for youth movements in the English sector and as episcopal vicar and later as regional vicar for pastoral ministry of Region II of the English sector.

## Msgr. Patrick Powers, P.H. - 25 years

Msgr. Powers obtained his licentiate in Canon Law at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. He is a Conventional Chaplain ad honorem of the Order of Malta. He helped organize Pope John Paul II's visit to Ottawa and has served the archdiocese as Moderator of the Curia, Episcopal Vicar for Administration, as a member of the Council of Priests and of the College of Consultors, and as Vicar General. An active member of the Canadian Canon Law Society, Msgr. Powers has served as the Society's president. He was a member of the Administrative Council of the Dominican University College. Before being named as General Secretary of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops in 2010, Msgr. Powers' last diocesan appointment was rector at Notre Dame Cathedral. During his time at the Cathedral, he contributed to the "Religion Experts" column in the *Ottawa Citizen*.
