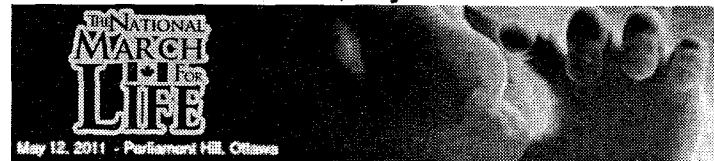
FAITH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
