I draw your attention to the case of one Father Jose Silva, Roman Catholic priest formerly of Hamilton Ont. Fr. Silva was spirited out of Canada to avoid facing a criminal charge of sexual assault by none other than an Assistant Crown Attorney (Carey Lee) and the priest's defence counsel (Dean Paquette).

Mr. Premier, I strongly believe that the public's faith in our justice system, and indeed the integrity of this system itself, has been seriously compromised.

I have made repeated attempts at voicing my concerns to your Attorney-General, the Hon. John Gerretsen. His office appears to be ignoring my correspondence. Even if this case is as sensitive as it appears to me, I would think that the A.G.'s office would at the very least acknowledge my correspondence. I am not looking for intimate details on the case. I DO want the Attorney'General's office to assure me that this case IS being investigated, and that it is at the very least CONSIDERING criminal charges against those parties who have colluded in this matter, including the Canadian Border Services.

I humbly beg your office to look into this matter, and give me some assurance that our justice system still has integrity.
