ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The First Reading for today places before us the prophet Nathan who was sent by God to reproach King David for his sin with Bathsheba, the wife of Uriah, and for ordering the heath of her husband in a battle with the Ammonites. David repents of his sin: *"I have sinned against the Lord"* (2 Sm. 12:13). Nathan then tells him: *"The Lord also has put away your sin; you shall not die"* (2 Sm. 12:13). The mercy of God is manifest toward the sinner who repents. David Loved the Lord. In a moment of weakness he fell and committed a grievous crime. He repented with all his heart, and God forgave him.

Charity, or love, is the fundamental motive and the necessary condition for forgiveness of sins, as pointed out in today's Gospel. While Jesus was dining in the home of a Pharisee, a woman known to be a notorious sinner entered and threw herself at His feet, weeping. Her tears fell upon His feet and she wiped them with her hair; she kissed those feet and then poured some perfumed oil on them.

The woman's sins were forgiven because she loved much – she loved Jesus in whom she saw God. It is true that love of God and sin are incompatible; but it is also true that real love of God can and does remove barriers that once separated us from God's friendship. St. Peter tells us as much with the words: *"Love covers a multitude of sins"* (1 Pt. 4:8); and St. John: *"We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brethren"* (1 Jn. 3:14); and again: *"He who loves me will be loved by my Father"* (Jn. 14:21). Loves does, indeed, blot out our sins. This woman loved much because she had listened to the words of Jesus and applied them to herself. She had great faith in Jesus and this engendered, or produced, great love in her heart. Faith and love are intimately linked together. They form the fundamental basis of our union with God.
