

Sterling House Plans For Swimming Pool

A new swimming facility will be installed for the Sterling house community center, according to Mrs. W. Grant Fitch and Bruno Primavera, co-directors of the day camp.

A 32 by 16 by four foot redwood swimming pool will be placed at the rear of the community center property, and is expected to be ready for use on the opening day of the day camp July 8.

The swimming program will be broadened, and certified Red Cross instructors will be in charge of the classes.

In addition to swimming, the Sterling house day camp program will include archery, crafts, skits, physical fitness, gymnastics, sports, music, dance, art and other classes.

Day camp registrations are now being accepted. Further information may be obtained by calling Sterling house, but registrations must be made in person at the main office, 2283 Main street.

Minimum age for campers is five and a half years, and a program has been planned for all ages to 12. A six-week session of the camp will be conducted, Monday through Friday, 9:30
