1874-1875: Fr. John Murphy & Fr. James Scanlon, administrators

1875-1879: Fr. John Ansboro

1880-1885: Fr. McCauley - rectory in Wyoming

1885-1887: Fr. Thomas Quigley - Forest and Warwick separated and become their own parish

1886-1910: Fr. Philip Gnam - Alvinston added as mission. 1887 St. Philip's built. 1888 Holy Rosary built. 1889 St. Anne's remodeled.

1910-1913: Fr. Hussey - rectory in Petrolia

1913-1926: Fr. J.N. Campeau - new St. Anne's built in Oil Springs

1926-1929: Fr. Powell

1929-1945: Msgr. P.J. Harrigan

1945-1948: Fr. Leo Kelly

1948: Fr. McMahon - illness cuts short his stay. Fr. Dunn buried at Mt. Calvary Cemetery

1948-1953: Fr. Mulkern
