WORK

he first work of our Congregation was that of Christian education and preaching, and we have always been a teaching community.

With this as our starting point we have adapted ourselves to serve God's people in many different branches of education and research - especially in schools, colleges, universities, graduate studies and publication – as well as in other forms of priestly work, particularly in parishes and missions. Whatever apostolic work we do, we are doing a single work of service, 'building up the Body of Christ.'

During the course of his lifetime, a Basilian priest is likely to serve the people of God in a variety of ways, since the work of evangelization and education is quite diverse. Basilians not only teach and administer high schools and universities, but also serve as

missionaries, parish priests and pastors, hospital chaplains, licensed counselors and therapists, retreat directors, peace-keepers and in the media.
