Father was ordained a priest in 1991, and has served in many different types of ministry. He has worked in formation, parish ministry, and retreat ministry, as hospital chaplain, provincial leadership in his religious community, and itinerant preacher. He is the National Priest for Worldwide Marriage Encounter, and is involved in presenting Marriage Encounter Weekends.

Most of Father Rocky's education was completed in Canada or Chicago. He is presently also working on his doctorate in Spirituality at Oblate School of Theology in San Antonio.

Before entering religious life, Father was a Federal Police Officer in Northern Canada. He was a Royal Canadian Police Officer for eight and half years. He has been stationed in Canada, Poland and the United States as he served in different ministries.
