

Bruce, of Ottawa, was shown by the large attendance at her funeral held at Renfrew on Tuesday.

Friends from Ottawa, Toronto, Montreal and many points in the Ottawa Valley, including Pembroke, Almonte, Eganville, and Lake Clear, joined with those from Renfrew to pay their last respects.

Mrs. Bruce, who had been living with her mother, Mrs. M. T. Stafford, at Renfrew, since she resumed teaching at the Renfrew separate school following the death of her husband in 1932, died in Ottawa on Saturday following an operation.

The funeral was held from the home of her mother to St. Francis Xavier Church, Renfrew, where solemn requiem high mass was chanted by Rev. Henry Maloney, of Combermere, assisted by Rev. J. J. Lynch, of Renfrew, and Rev. J. Kelly, O.M.I., of St. Patrick's College, Ottawa. The body was met at the church door by Rev. T. J. Wingle. Rev. John Sullivan, of Calabogie, said mass at the side
