Bishop's Announcement

For anyone that was not at our Parish Masses last weekend, the Bishop's Announcement:

"I am here this weekend at St. Martin of Tours Parish to inform you that Fr. Ken Rae the Pastor has made a decision to resign from Parish Ministry due to reasons which are personal and health related. I have accepted his resignation effective this weekend.

At this time I have no further information to offer or share with you but should this change in the future I will keep you informed.

I have asked Fr. Peter Wayow, a retired religious priest and Spiritan to assume the Pastoral care of the Parish of St. Martin of Tours in the coming weeks. This appointment as administrator is temporary until the normal Diocesan Pastoral moves in July 2016 and the assigning of a new Pastor.

I realize that this announcement is received by many of you with a certain degree of shock and sadness. I extend to any of you the invitation to please approach me after the Mass to express such feelings or concerns.

I ask your prayers for Fr. Ken Rae and for all of us here present that we may experience healing and renewed strength through the Paschal Mystery of Christ that we celebrate in this Mass this evening (day)."

Welcome Fr. Peter!

Fr. Peter Wayow C.S.Sp. Was born in the island nation of Trinidad. In 1959, he journeyed to Quebec to join the religious order known as the Spiritans or the Congregation of the Holy Ghost. He completed his priestly studies in Canada, Ireland and Trinidad.

After his ordination in 1970, he was sent to the South American country of Paraguay where he spent 13 years. In 1985, he was appointed Pastor of a Parish in Toronto, and 13 years later, he served as Pastor of Dundalk in the diocese of Hamilton for 17 years.

Fr. Peter officially retired in June of 2015 but has been helping out in Parishes in the Dioceses of Kingston and Peterborough. His latest appointment is to our Parish of St. Martin of Tours here in Ennismore where he will serve as Parish Administrator until the end of June 2016.

Fr. Peter has only been with us a few days, but he describes our Parish as "a little piece of heaven" and its people as "beautiful in every way"
