

Aylmer Priest Chairman Ecumenical Commission

His Excellency Bishop Carter announced Tuesday the resignation of Monsignor J. A. Feeney from the office of chairman of the London Diocesan Ecumenical Commission. Bishop Carter named as successor to Monsignor Feeney the Rev. James F. Blondé, who assumes his new office immediately and will also continue as associate pastor of Our Lady of Sorrows Parish, Aylmer. Monsignor Feeney was chairman of the Ecumenical Commission since its inception in December, 1963.
