## Baptism Preparation



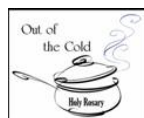

**EDUCATION & ACTION CAMPAIGN 2007-2008**

Last February, 575 members of Holy Rosary Parish joined with more than 152,000 Canadians in requesting our Prime Minister to set in place legal mechanisms that would ensure that Canadian mining companies respect international human rights and environmental standards in their operations abroad. On the weekend of March 2, you will be invited to sign a petition to our Prime Minister that his government establish an independent ombudsperson to receive complaints about Canadian mining companies that fail to behave in a responsible manner abroad.

Development and Peace's campaign is guided by six principles based on the Church's social teaching. Last weekend, the first two of six principles that guide Development and Peace's current education and action campaign were included in an insert in our parish bulletin. The six principles are inspired by the social teaching of the Church. They inform us that when the livelihood of local communities in the Global South are jeopardized, we cannot be silent. Here are two more of the six principles that Development and Peace says must be honoured when Canadian mining companies conduct business in the Global South:

*Principle No. 3:* People have the right to participate fully in and have control over the decisions that affect their daily life.

*Principle No. 4:* In the interest of solidarity and the common good, decisions made for the benefit of one community must not violate the rights of other communities.
