



All documents and information in my possession, including all correspondence to and from your lawyer will now be made available to WHOMEVER. Also included is the information of the recent sale of the cottage at Little Lake, for the princely sum of \$84,000.00 - AMAZINGLY - only 2 years ago appraised at \$56,500.00.

Discussed with and on the advise of Msgr. John Murphy, Chancellor of the Archdiocese of Toronto, all the aforementioned documents and information will be forwarded to the Apostolic Nuncio in Ottawa and the Congregation of Clergy in Rome, for their ecclesiastical records.

Re: Father Mark Buckley


I received a call from Father Mark earlier today advising that he has received reports that you have ignored his previous requests to have no further contact with him. He has received reports that earlier this week, while you were in Regina, you contacted Father Dan Stevenot requesting information on Father Mark's current posting. You then called Cathy Hickey in Peterborough requesting similar information. I understand you were given information concerning Father Mark's current address.

In the event you did not fully appreciate the request made in my letter of July 2, 1999, let me be perfectly clear: Father Mark considers your contacts with his employers, friends and associates, harassing conduct. Continued contact with Father Mark, directly or indirectly, cannot be seen as an honest mistake on your part. Father Mark now fears for his safety; he feels he is being stalked by you.

If there is lawful need to CONTACT conduct Father Mark in future, all such communication must be done **in writing** through this office. I have been instructed not to engage in any telephone dialogue on this matter.

I trust the foregoing makes clear the intention of the July 2 correspondence.
