

He has refrained from doing so in the belief that a polite request to you to cease and desist from further contacts with others regarding any perceived difficulties you have with Father Mark will suffice.

I can assure you that issues you are raising are presently being investigated in full and any input you can make at the present time is at best superfluous and at worst malicious. Father Mark kindly requests that you refrain from contacting anyone at any time hereafter.

Should you persist in making contacts, the parties named above will keep record of your contacts and take such action as deemed appropriate without further notice to you.
