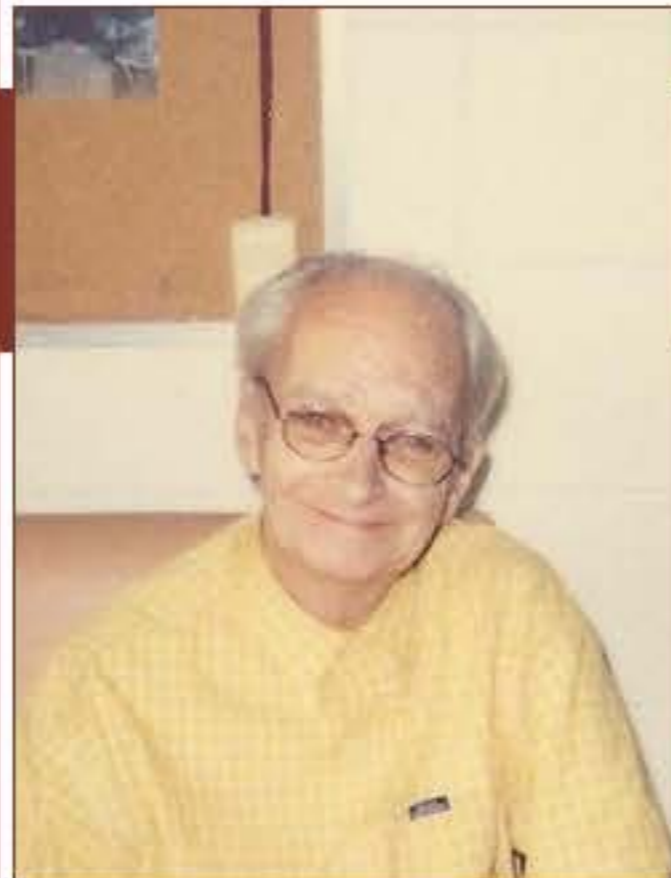

BIOGRAPHY
