**From the Office of the Bishop's Delegate - 12 March 2018**

It was announced on Thanksgiving weekend that allegations had been made against Fr. Moe Charbonneau. He was subsequently removed from the parishes in which he was serving. No criminal charges have been laid against him, and the allegation involved an inappropriate adult relationship. It has been discovered through an investigation that the incident first reported to the diocese was not an isolated incident of misconduct; rather, there have been several incidents over the years.

Our hope in placing this notice in the bulletins where Fr. Moe served is two-fold: we need to reach out to see if there are any other persons involved, and we need to let others know that we take these situations seriously.
